As your child's parent or guardian, you have the right to decline the ESOL program proposed to you or to have your child removed from the ESOL program at any time by contacting your child's school. If you are dissatisfied for any reason, please follow these steps in order:

Complaint Procedures

1. First, contact Mrs. Jean Fahey, Program Coordinator and I will do my best to answer any questions or resolve any issues you might have. If you feel your concerns have not been adequately resolved, please proceed to the next step.
2. Contact the building principal. If you believe your concerns have not been adequately resolved, please proceed to the next step.
3. Contact the School District Superintendent. If you believe your concerns have not been resolved, you may file a formal complaint with the NH Department of Education.
4. If you need an interpreter or translator to assist you with this process, one will be provided for you.
